VIZcellose 1.0% Product Information

VIZcellose 1.0% is a sterile, ophthalmic extra strong moisturising and protective solution, with a physiological pH, based upon Carmellose. VIZcellose 1.0% does not contain preservatives. The absence of preservatives allows the use of the solution by contact lens wearers without the need of removing them.

Composition

1.0% Carmellose sodium (carboxymethyl cellulose), boric acid, sodium tetraborate decahydrate, sodium chloride, water for injection.

Indications

VIZcellose 1.0% relieves symptoms of dry eyes such as burning, itching, and foreign body sensation. It also acts as a lubricant, providing relief of dry eye conditions, including those associated with the use of PCs, infrequent blinking, certain medical treatments, atmospheric pollution, dry atmospheres (e.g. air conditioning, wind and sun) and ophthalmic stress due to the use of eye lenses.

VIZcellose 1.0% can be used in case of a severe dry eye syndrome or more immediate protective action and lasting relief.

Common Side Effects

The product can cause a short-term blurring of vision after use. The patient should be advised not to drive or use machines until their sight is clear.

Like all eye drops, there is a slight possibility that the product can occasionally cause mild eye irritation or stinging or itching, but this usually soon passes, and it can occur in a very small number of people.

Dosage or instructions for use

Instil 1-2 drops in each eye.

Suitable for frequent use. Can be used 3 or 4 times, or more often if required to provide sufficient hydration.

As dry eye is a condition which varies from person to person, the drops should be used as often as necessary.

The gradual emptying of the bottle may be associated with the need to exert a higher pressure to allow the delivery of the product. This is due to the proprieties of the closure system act to preserve the sterility and the chemical and physical characteristics of preservative free solutions.

Warnings

The product is for single patient use.

The product is only intended for ophthalmic use.

Care should be taken during application, not to touch the eye and any other surface with the dropper of the container.

Contraindicated in patients with a history of hypersensitivity to any of the components.

Keep away from children.
