

VIZhyal 0.1% Product Information

VIZhyal 0.1% is a sterile, ophthalmic soothing and moisturising solution, with physiological pH, based upon sodium hyaluronate. VIZhyal 0.1% does not contain preservative. The absence of preservatives allows the use of the solution by contact lens wearers without the need of removing them.

Composition

Sodium hyaluronate 0.1%, sodium phosphate monobasic monohydrate, sodium phosphate dibasic dodecahydrate, sodium chloride, water for injection.

Indications

VIZhyal 0.1% relieves symptoms of moderate dry eyes such as burning, itching, and foreign body sensation. It also acts as a humectant and lubricant, providing relief of dry eye conditions, including:

- those associated with the use of PCs
- infrequent blinking
- certain medical treatments
- atmospheric pollution, dry atmospheres (e.g. air conditioning, wind and sun)
- ophthalmic stress due to the use of contact lenses.

Common Side Effects

Minor burning or stinging may temporarily occur as a result of ocular irritation.

Dosage or instructions for use

Instil 1-2 drops in each eye.

Suitable for frequent use. Can be used 2 or 3 times, or more often if required.

The gradual emptying of the bottle may be associated with the need to exert a higher pressure to allow the delivery of the product. This is due to the properties of the closure system act to preserve the sterility and the chemical and physical characteristics of preservative free solutions.

Warnings

The product is for single patient use.

The product is only intended for ophthalmic use.

Care should be taken during application, not to touch the eye and any other surface with the dropper of the container.

Contraindicated in patients with a history of hypersensitivity to any of the components.

Keep away from children.
